HONG KONG JUNIOR RANKINGS 2011

GENERAL RANKING INFORMATION

Hong Kong Junior Ranking points are available at all junior tournaments sanctioned by the Hong Kong Tennis Association. In order to get a ranking a player must reach a round where points are available. The number of points available in each round will vary depending on the grading of the tournament and the round reached.

In ranking a particular age group, only results of matches played in that age group will be considered.

EVENTS

The HKTA sanctions the following events to be used to determine Hong Kong Junior Rankings:

Boys: 10 & Under, 12 & Under, 14 & Under, 18 & Under

Girls: 10 & Under, 12 & Under, 14 & Under, 18 & Under

TOURNAMENT GRADES

Local junior tournaments are divided into the following grades:

Grade I National Junior Tennis Championships (Main Draw)
Junior Tennis Series Grand Masters
School Boys' and School Girls' Open Singles and School Boys' Doubles of CRC
Open (18 & 14 under age group only) (Main Draw)

Grade II Junior Team Series Competitions

YEAR-END RANKINGS

Players must play in the National Junior Championships or play at least two Hong Kong Junior Tennis Series competitions; or represent Hong Kong in an ITF Team event (including World Junior Team Tennis, Junior Davis Cup or Junior Fed Cup) and play the National Championships or at least one Junior Series Competition to be eligible for ITF ranking point conversion and ATF points conversion for the official end of year National Ranking.

2. International Events

2.1 ITF Junior Circuit Points Conversion

The ITF ranking will be converted to the 18 & under of Hong Kong Junior Ranking. One ITF ranking point is equivalent to three HKTA ranking points.

2.2 ITF Team Events Points Conversion

For any player who will be unable to participate in any local junior tournament because of representing Hong Kong in ITF team events (Davis Cup, Fed Cup, World Junior Tennis, Junior Davis Cup and Junior Fed Cup), bonus points will be awarded in that relevant age group:

Davis Cup & Fed Cup	18 & Under

Bonus Points awarded:

Participation Points: 4 bonus points will be awarded in SINGLES ranking.

Match Winning Points:

No further bonus points will be given for winning 4 or more matches.

2.3 ATF Events Points Conversion

For player who participate in the ATF events (Asian 14U Series Tournaments and Asian 14 U Championships), bonus point will be awarded to the 14 U age group.

Ranking Points Carry Forward



At the beginning of each year ranking points from last year will be carried over to this year for the same age group (carry over will not be applied over different age groups). 75% of last year points earned for the first competition, 50% of last year points earned for the second competition, 25% of last year points earned for the third competition. After that, no further points will be carried over. Formulas as follows:

	10, 12, 14 age groups	18 age groups
After the 1st tournament:	Total ranking pts from last year x 75%	(Total ranking pts from last year minus ITF ranking pts in 31 Dec last year) x 75%
After the 2nd tournament:	Total ranking pts from last year x 50%	(Total ranking pts from last year minus ITF ranking pts in 31 Dec last year) x 50%
After the 3rd tournament:	Total ranking pts from last year x 25%	(Total ranking pts from last year minus ITF ranking pts in 31 Dec last year) x 25%
After the 4th tournament:	No further points will be carrier over.	No further points will be carried over

The calculation of ranking points will be from 1 Jan – 31 Dec every year.

OTHERS

Walkovers should be reported to the HKTA 24 hours prior to the match with written notice. Points earned in the previous round will be deducted for any walkovers without advance written notice. If a player is walked over for medical reasons, no penalties will be made. Doctor certificate should be submitted to HKTA within 3 days of the match.

Defaults occur when a player is not allowed by the referee to begin or continue a match or refuses to play for other than a bona fide reason. Such a default will count as a win for the opponent. No ranking points will be earned from the tournament. The Tournament committee has a right to suspend the player from participating in any tournament for a certain period.

Corrections

It is the player's responsibility to check that his or her Hong Kong Junior Ranking is correct. Any perceived anomalies, incorrect spellings, change of address or queries regarding the Hong Kong Junior Rankings should be reported in writing or email to the Hong Kong Tennis Association.

NOTE: From time to time and at its discretion, the Tournament Committee may amend the regulations and points structure of this system. All decisions made by the Tournament Committee shall be final.
