- 1. What is the Coach Licensing Scheme?
 - Organized and launched by the Hong Kong Tennis Association to address the needs of tennis coaching, and enhance coaching standards in Hong Kong.
 - The Scheme comprises four levels:
 - MTL HKTA Mini-Tennis Licence
 - CL1 HKTA Coach Licence 1
 - CL2 HKTA Coach Licence 2
 - CL3 HKTA Coach Licence 3
- 2. What are the significances of the Scheme:
 - To initiate and maintain tennis coaching standards in Hong Kong
 - To safeguard the interests of the tennis playing public
 - To provide a formal recognition for coaches
 - To classify the ability levels of qualified coaches
 - To offer channels for coaches in Hong Kong to pursue continuous and lifetime professional development
 - To provide the public with updated information on licensed coaches
- 3. Who are eligible to obtain the coaching licenses?

Anyone who meets the following requirements can obtain the license:

- An HKTA-recognized coach and holding qualifications recognized by the HKTA.
- A Hong Kong resident or person legally allowed to work in Hong Kong.
- In good standing with the HKTA.
- In compliance with the Code of Ethics and Conduct for Coaches as set by the HKTA.
- 4. How can a Licensed Coach be identified?
 - His/her name and qualification listed on HKTA website www.tennishk.org
 - He/she carries a valid Coach Licence Identity Card
- 5. When will the Scheme be launched?
 - Commencement date: April 1, 2003.
 - Application period: March 1 to March 31 of each year.
