1. Hong Kong National Ranking Point System

HKCTA awards Hong Kong National Ranking Points to HKCTA-organized or sanctioned events as follows:

2. Basis of Calculation

The Hong Kong National Ranking is calculated based on the Best SIX (6) Results of local or international events that gain ATP or WTA points, on a 52-week rolling basis.

3. Withdrawal

- Ranking points will not be deducted if a player withdraws from the competition with a 24-hour advance written notice to the tournament or is due to a medical condition. In case of a medical condition, a medical note from a medical practitioner must be provided within 3 days of the date of the withdrawn match. (Subject to 3c)
- If a player withdraws from the competition without a 24-hour advance written notice to the tournament, or is not due to a medical condition, only the points from the previous round are calculated towards his/her ranking in the competition. i. e. If a player withdraws without 24-hour advance written notice from the Quarter Final in the Open Singles event of the Hong Kong National Tennis Championship, he or she will only be awarded the ranking points from the Round of 16, which is 300 points. (Subject to 3c)
- No ranking points will be awarded for players who are main draw Direct Acceptance and Withdraw from the competition.

- Remarks:
- Direct Acceptance, Wild Cards in Main Draw will get 1st Round loser Points
 - Lucky Loser: No points will be given unless player won the 1st Round match in Main Draw.

4. ATP and WTA Conversion

The basis of conversion is as follows:

Singles

1 ATP or WTA point = 1,600 Hong Kong National Ranking points

Doubles

1 ATP or WTA point = 400 Hong Kong National Ranking points

Remarks for ITF Tournament:

1. Lucky Loser: No points will be given unless player won the 1st Round match in Main Draw.

Hong Kong National Ranking Points are also awarded to singles qualifying round of Men ITF World Tennis Tour and Women ITF World Tennis Tour events as follows. However, points are not awarded to 1st Round losers in qualifying round.

Remarks:

1. The Hong Kong National Rankings will be calculated electronically by a software commencing 1st April 2020. All players are required to sign up for a free HKCTA PIN account [[Sign Up](#)] in order to be included in the rankings.
2. In order to capture points from results of ITF World Tennis Tour (Men and Women), WTA or ATP events held in other countries, players must submit the result(s) of overseas tournaments for conversion into Hong Kong National Ranking. Conversion points will be updated in the next publication. Otherwise the results will not be accounted for.
3. Only players that hold a valid Hong Kong Identity Card or a travel document proving residency in Hong Kong will have a Hong Kong National Ranking.
