



A Golden Weekend for Hong Kong Pickleball – PPA Tour Asia Hong Kong Open 2025 Wrap-Up



The curtain has closed on an unforgettable chapter in Hong Kong's sporting history — the **PPA Tour Asia Hong Kong Open 2025** concluded on **Sunday, 24 August**, at the world-class Kai Tak Arena, and what a weekend it was!

With over 100 elite professionals and 400 passionate amateur players from **25 countries or regions**, the tournament celebrated the explosive rise of pickleball in Asia. And leading the charge was **Hong Kong's own Wong Hong Kit**, who delivered a spectacular performance on the home court.

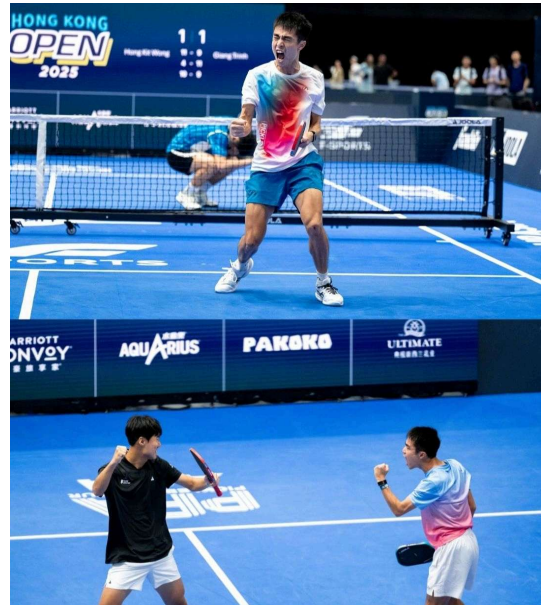
Wong Hong Kit: The homegrown Hero

Wong dazzled fans with a **gold medal in Men's Singles** and a **silver in Men's Doubles**, showcasing grit, precision, and the power of home-court spirit.

In Singles, Wong overcame **Malaysia leg champion Giang Trinh** in a dramatic three-set final, rallying from behind to clinch victory 11-9 in the decider.

In Doubles, Wong and partner **Kim Eungwon** battled through a thrilling semifinal and pushed the **American duo Thomas Yu and Len Yang** to the limit in the final, earning a well-fought silver.

"Winning this event is especially meaningful here in Hong Kong, particularly as it's the most globally recognized tournament of its kind," Wong shared, thanking fans, family, and coaches for their unwavering support.



Women's Division – International Excellence and Local Promise



The women's events showcased world-class talent and rising stars, with **Roos van Reek of the Netherlands** delivering a dominant performance to claim **double gold** in Singles and Doubles.

In the **Women's Singles final**, Roos van Reek defeated **Hsieh Yu-Chieh of Chinese Taipei** in straight sets (11–2, 11–3), combining powerful baseline play with pinpoint accuracy. Her composure and consistency throughout the tournament made her a standout champion.

Hong Kong's Wong Hong Yi made a strong impression by reaching the bronze medal match in Women's Singles. She battled valiantly against **Long Yufei (CHN)**, narrowly missing the podium in a close contest (10–12, 7–11), but her performance reflected the growing strength of Hong Kong's female players on the international stage.



In **Women's Doubles**, Roos teamed up with **Wei Ting Chieh (TPE)** to overcome the formidable pairing of **Long Yufei (CHN)** and **Xiao Yi Wang-Beckvall (USA)**, winning 11–4, 11–3 in a fast-paced final that highlighted their seamless teamwork and aggressive net play.

Beyond the competition, the event embraced the spirit of **“Play Where the Pros Play,”** welcoming **424 amateur athletes** across **34 categories** and hosting **883 matches** over four days.
